Guatemala Travel Requirements

Vaccines required by GL:

- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- Tetanus
- Typhoid
- Polio
- Malaria (pills while on the trip)
- Yellow Fever (you must receive and carry yellow International Prophylaxis card)

Some doctors also recommend a Meningitis and Rabies vaccine, although it is not required by GL.

Passport Requirements:

You must have your passport by March 1st, 2016. You will receive a Visa application packet during week of February 22-26th.

The following will be due to Nubia Cazares in H-1 by Monday, April 20th.

- Completed Visa application packet
- Roughly \$75 Visa payment
- Passport
